

How to upgrade the firmware on your DIR-router.

Attention! Do not perform an upgrade over a wireless connection

Start up internet explorer and type in <http://192.168.0.1> in the address bar.

If you would like to configure the Internet settings of your new D-Link Router manually, then click on the Manual Configure button below.

- If you are new to networking and have never configured a router before, click on **Setup Wizard** and the router will run you through a few simple steps to get your network up and running.
- If you consider yourself an Advanced user and have configured a router before, click **Manual Configure** to input all the settings manually.

Click on the menu **[Tools]**, and click on **[Firmware]** on the left side of the screen.
